

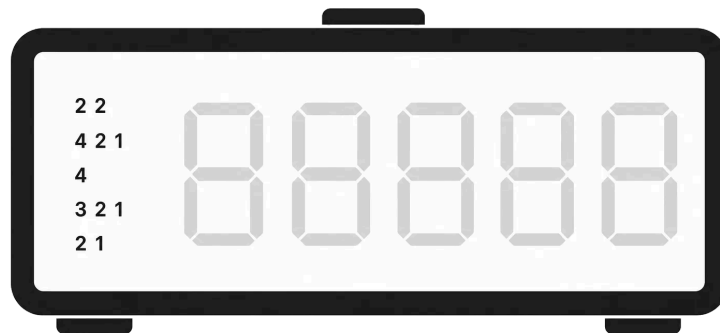


Room 5: Master bedroom
